

Ms. Seibert-Volz stated that the Public Safety Commission met earlier in the day and felt it was imperative that the ordinance related to public use of cannabis and hemp be adopted as soon as possible. Ordinances are not in effect until they are published in the official newspaper. Therefore, an emergency meeting was called so that the ordinance will be in effect next week, before many events take place the weekend of August 12.

Police Chief Jake Maier noted that the proposed ordinance is being used by many cities across the State.
