RESOLUTION NO. 26-21
INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT AND JOBS ACT (IIJA)
STATE MATCH FUNDING – PROJECT SAP 018-589-002

WHEREAS, the City of Crosslake (City) has applied for and received state funding intended to be used as a match to federal IIJA funding that was previously approved for a Safe Streets For All (SS4A) Planning grant, and

WHEREAS, the amount of the state grant has been approved for up to \$50,000, and


WHEREAS, Crow Wing County (County) must administer the funds and act as the project sponsor on behalf of the City, and

WHEREAS, the City shall be responsible for engaging a consultant, delivering the project, providing close-out and final documents and providing the necessary data to the County when requesting release of the funds, and


WHEREAS, the City understands that only consultant costs are eligible for reimbursement from the state grant and that public agency staff time is not eligible.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City hereby agrees to allow the County to accept the state funding, and further agrees to be responsible for all costs related to the project above and beyond the amount of the state funding. The federal IIJA funding being utilized for the project is done by direct agreement between the City and the federal government.
